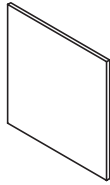
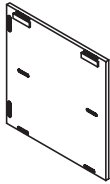
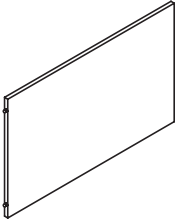
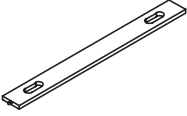
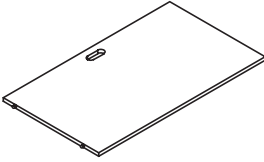
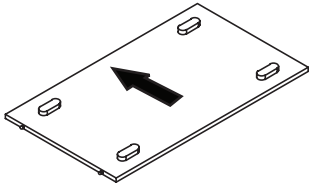
Open Shelving (Stacking)

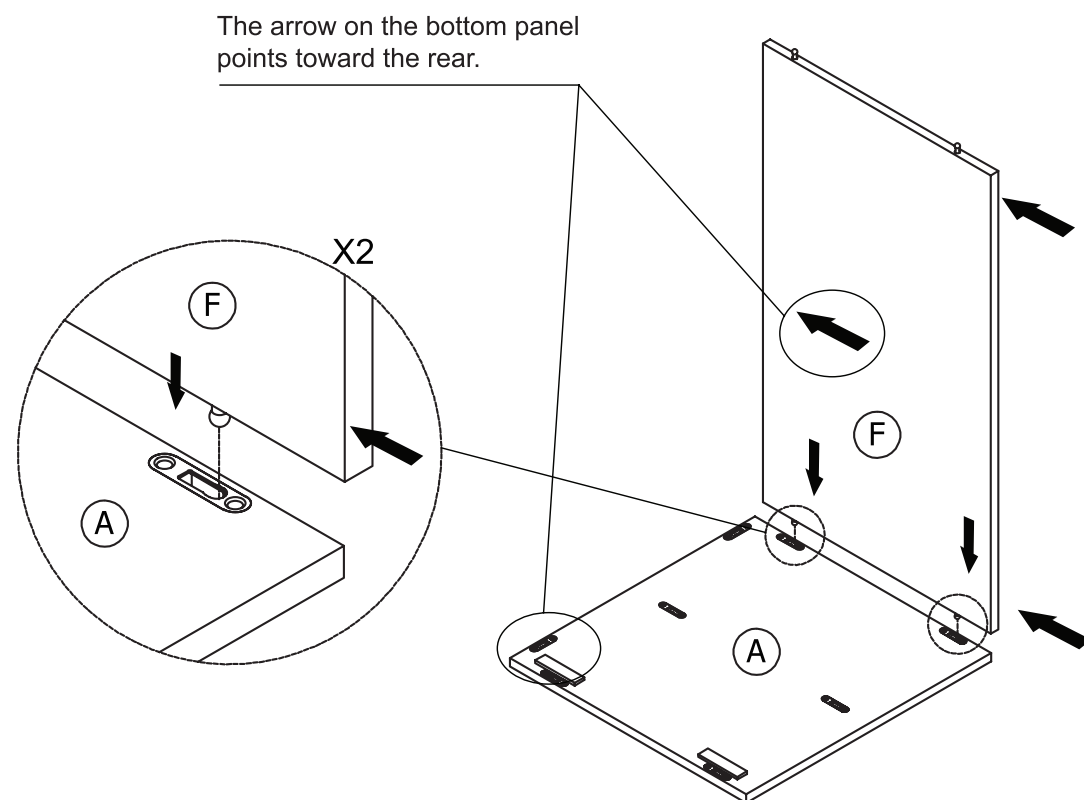

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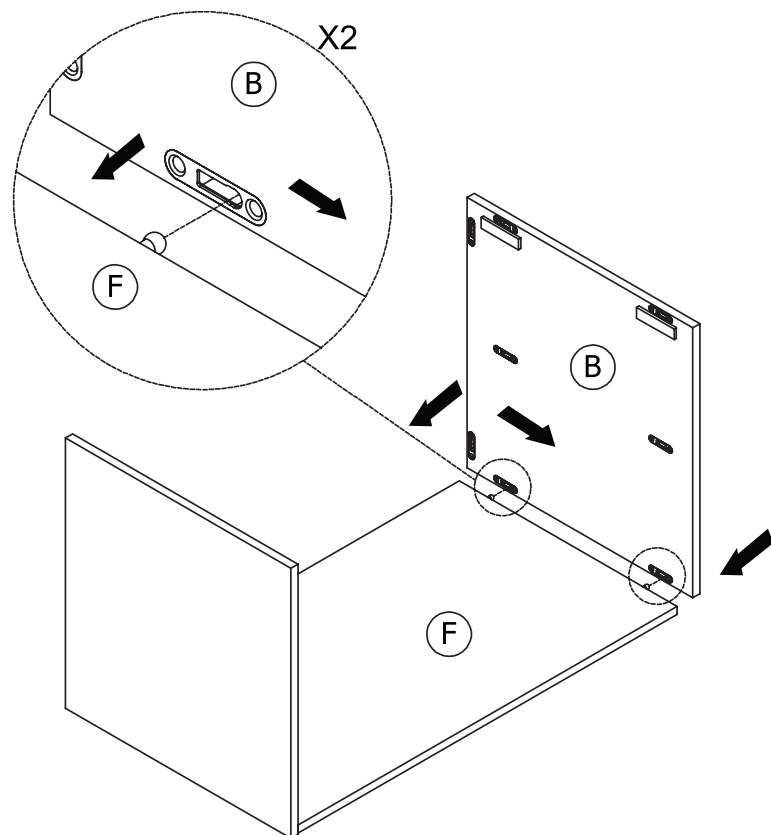

Insert F vertically into A, aligning the connectors and ensuring they are securely locked in place.



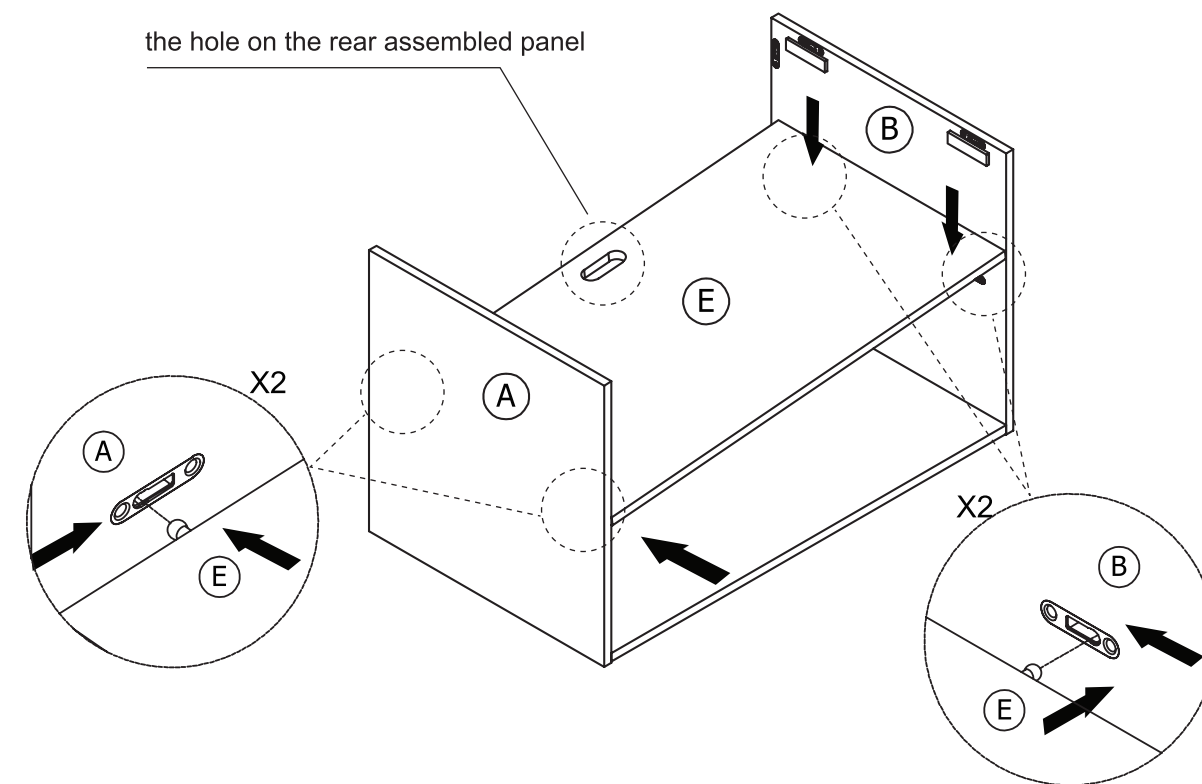

Attach connector B to panel F and push it in the direction of the arrow until it clicks into place.



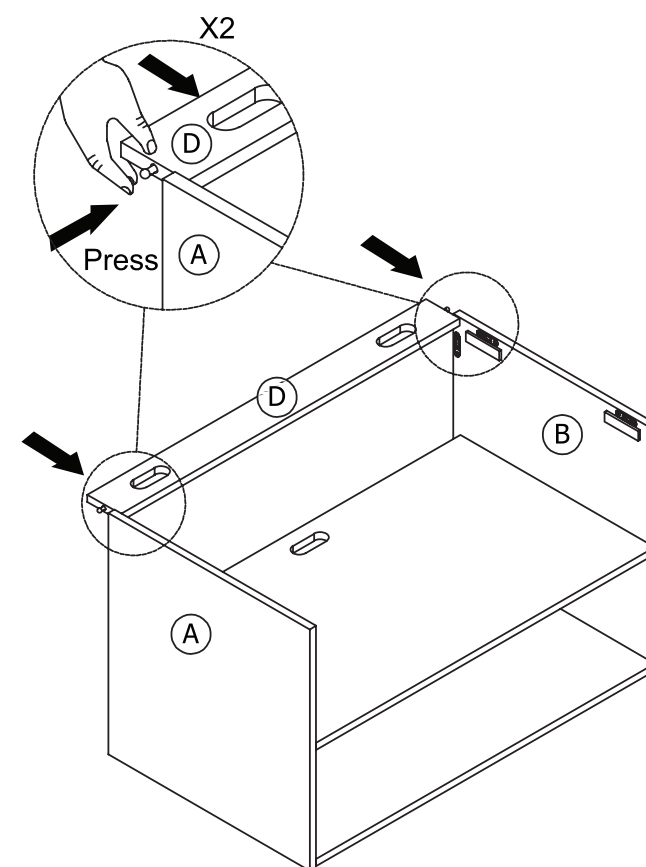

Insert the middle shelf E into the slots between panels A and B. Align the connectors and push in the direction of the arrow until both sides are firmly attached.



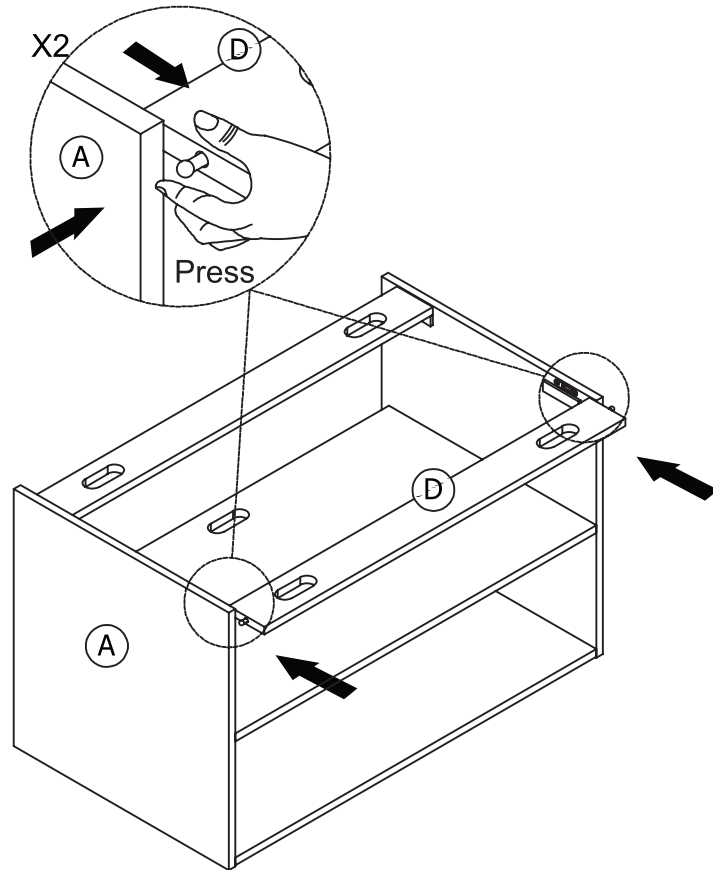

Install the top connector D. Align the latch, press in the direction of the arrow, and push in until it locks securely in place.



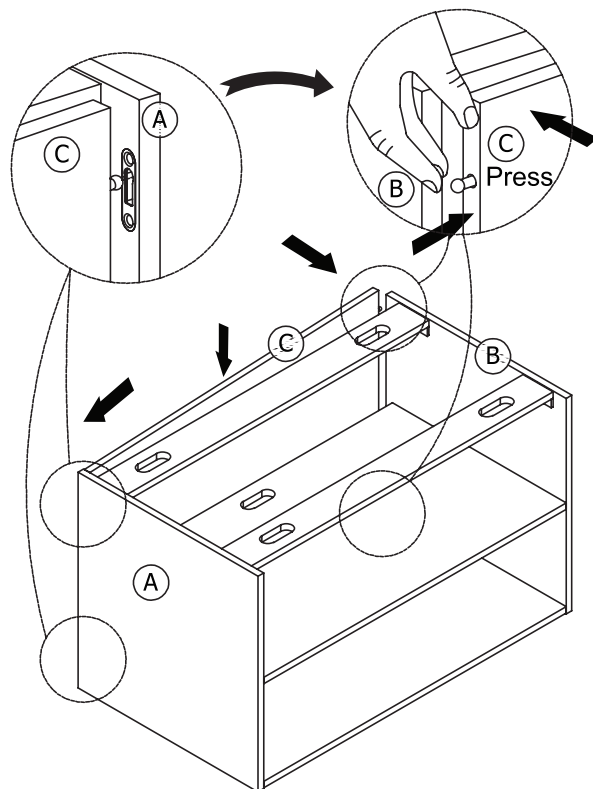

Align the latch, push in the direction of the arrow.



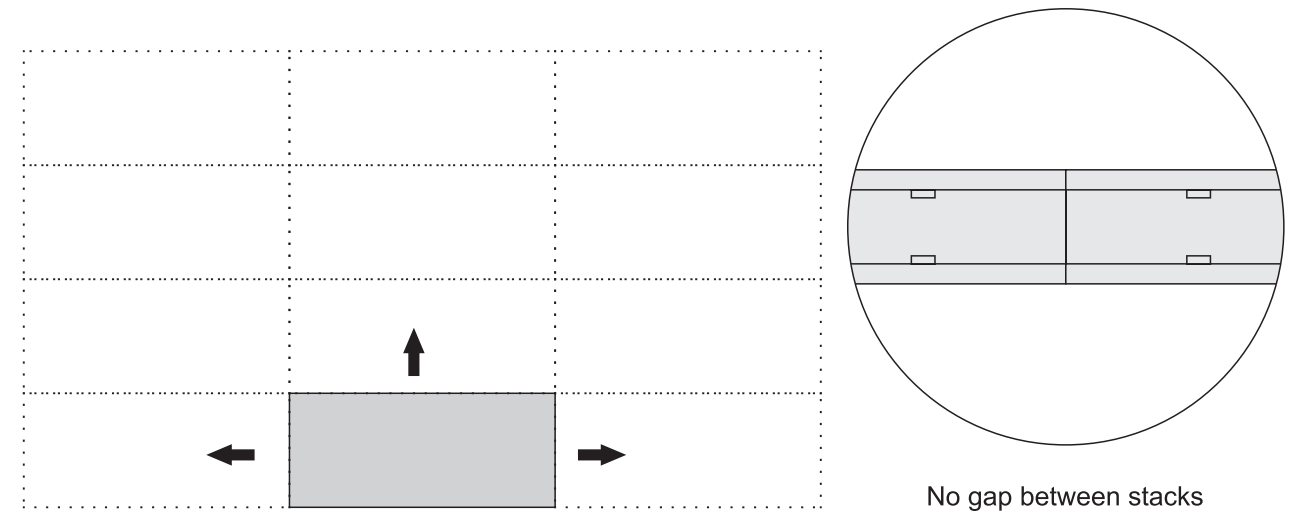

Attach the back panel C to the side panels A and B.

Repeat stacking and securing units until desired configuration is reached. Ensure there is no gap between stacks if configuration expands horizontally.



IMPORTANT

Do not stack higher than 59". Stacking higher than 59" can cause units to topple over if pulled on.
